Registration begins at 9:00 am. NOTE THE NEW LOCATION! Registration will be set up along the SOUTH end of the facility. After dropping your clubs at the club drop area near the pool entrance, park in the lot near the fitness center and Drive Zone signage. Driving range opens at 9 am.

Be sure to bring cash for a few on-course contests. These contests contribute to the success of the tournament and you will be rewarded with plenty of “complimentary samplings” during your round! Cash or Club Corp account will be required for additional purchases during play.

10:50 am Opening Prayer at cart staging area. Instructions and review of rules.

11 am Departure from the cart staging area. Shotgun start on Championship Course shortly thereafter.

Food and beverage service begins at the Brookhaven Drive Zone 4:30pm. Fajita buffet and cash bar. Non-golfing adults are welcome to join us. Tournament Notes & Rules

The tournament is a four-person scramble format. Each player on a four-person team will have the opportunity to hit every shot. The team will then decide which ball gives them the best chance for a low score and will drop within one club length of that ball. Once on the putting surface, balls may not be moved. **NOTE: Each player's drive must be used at least 3 times during the round.** One club length rule applies to hazards and rough, but balls cannot be moved onto a different surface. Example: If a team chooses to play a ball out of the rough, then the ball can be moved one club length within the rough but not from the rough into the fairway. Par is the highest score on any one hole.
